An entry fee of ten dollars is payable for each artwork by Adults, with free entry for Sculptors under the age of 18yrs.

All sculptures must pass the committee's concepts of acceptable public art and relate to the theme of sustainability and, or use recycled materials. The work must be able to be carried to the designated area by the artist/s and assembled in position during the prescribed times on the designated day and then disassembled and removed during the prescribed time on the designated day. The Artist/s must disassemble and remove all evidence of work between the hours of 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm on the same day and leave the display site in good condition.

ALL WORK MUST BE SAFE, STABLE and form no hazard to any member of the public.
ALL WORK MUST BE DURABLE IN IT'S DESIGN to withstand variable weather conditions.
All sculptures are displayed at the sculptors own risk, every care is taken but the organisers accept no responsibility for loss and/or damage.

The organiser's decisions are final, no disputes will be entered into.
